WHEREAS, after Public Hearing, the members of the City Council voted on the adoption of the proposed Local Law as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MECHANICVILLE THAT THE FOLLOWING LOCAL LAW IS HEREBY ENACTED, EFFECTIVE UPON FILING PURSUANT TO LOCAL AND STATE LAW.

§ 33. Preparation of assessment roll.

The Assessor shall cause to be prepared, in manner and form as nearly as may be prescribed by the tax laws of the state, an assessment roll of all property within the City, and the Assessor shall, in addition to the information required by law, state separately the value of the land exclusive of the improvements thereon and the value of the land with the improvements thereon. The valuation date upon which the value of property is established shall be July 1, of the preceding year.

§ 35. Completion of assessment roll; notice.

The Taxable Status Date shall be first day of March of each year. The Assessor shall complete the assessment roll on or before the first day of May in each year and shall deposit said roll in his/her office and cause to be published in an official newspaper a notice that the assessment roll is completed and on deposit in his/her office and that it may there be examined during the hours said office is regularly open for business during the 10 days next after the publication of said notice, and that the Board of Assessment Review will meet in relation to the assessments of real property on the fourth Tuesday in May of each year. The hours of such meeting as fixed by the Board of Assessment Review. A statement that a publication containing procedures for contesting an assessment is available in the Assessor's office. The Final Assessment roll date will be July 1 of each year.
