On Saturday, May 27, 2023, Mechanicville Police attempted to stop a white Audi on N. Central Ave at about 7:30 pm after the operator committed several vehicle & traffic law violations. Instead of pulling over, the operator sped off, leading officers on a pursuit through Halfmoon, which was eventually called off for safety purposes; the operator was driving at an excessive speed and into oncoming traffic. The operator, Jordan McCullen, was quickly identified with the assistance of Troy PD, and a warrant was sought. McCullen was arrested today on an outstanding warrant resulting from that pursuit. This is the second time MPD has arrested McCullen following a pursuit. On November 30, 2021, McCullen led Waterford PD on a pursuit that terminated in Mechanicville after McCullen struck a police car and damaged property on Terminal Street. He was arraigned in Mechanicville City Court and turned over to the NYSP for processing on other charges.

The Mechanicville Police Department recognizes that persons arrested for crimes are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. People reviewing these arrests should understand that an arrest is often the first step of many in the criminal justice process.
