On Thursday, May 25, 2023, Mechanicville police arrested Tyler Pace on the above-listed charges following an investigation into a domestic dispute at a city residence. Police initially responded after it was reported that Pace violated an order of protection by causing a disturbance at the protected person's residence. Pace had fled the area by the time police arrived. He was later spotted operating a vehicle and, when stopped and taken into custody, was found to have a suspended license. Pace was arraigned in Mechanicville City Court and remanded to the custody of the Sheriff's Office in lieu of bail pending further action.

The Mechanicville Police Department recognizes that persons arrested for crimes are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. People reviewing these arrests should understand that an arrest is often the first step of many in the criminal justice process.
